We will be fully complying with all FDA, State and Local guidance regarding meetings. We are working closely with the Loews to ensure we are creating a safe and secure environment for all our guests and staff. You can view their policies [here](#). Below, we have outlined some FAQs. These FAQs will be revised should guidelines change prior to the opening of our Santa Monica Summit.

Q Is NetDiligence Staff vaccinated?

A NetDiligence® staff are held to the same standard as the rest of the community, proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test..

Q Are we requiring proof of vaccination/proof of negative COVID-19 test results?

A Keeping you safe at our events is our first responsibility. In responding to recent new exposures posed by the "Delta" variant of COVID-19, and reflective of recent State of California trends in COVID-19 management, NetDiligence will require proof of COVID vaccination (copy of CDC card, any means of photo/digital copy acceptable) or the results of a COVID-19 test obtained within 72 hours of the start of the Santa Monica Cyber Risk Summit. Upon check-in at the Santa Monica Cyber Risk Summit, you will be required to present evidence of either fully vaccinated status or the negative results from a COVID-19 test completed within 72 hours of the start of the Summit. Please contact us if you have any specific questions on this requirement.

Q Are we doing temperature checks?

A No, but we ask all attendees to behave in a responsible manner by monitoring yourself and if you have a fever or cold/flu-type symptoms, you will stay home.

Q What should I do if I start feeling sick during the conference?

A Please contact the conference staff immediately should you start feeling ill. We will assess the situation and provide appropriate resources for testing and isolation, if necessary.

Q Are face masks required during meetings?

A Yes. When indoors, individuals must wear a face covering, irrespective of physical distance.

Q Are face masks required during eating?

A No. When eating, individuals may remove their face covering while seated at their table.

Q What types of things are you doing to keep attendees safe?

- A** There are many protocols being put in place to ensure everyone's safety.
1. We are implementing a new contactless registration system for check-in. This includes scanning technology to confirm compliance with capacity restrictions.
 2. We will be deploying a Covid Safety Monitor to both help ensure compliance with safety protocols, and to serve as a resource for any Covid safety concerns our delegates may have.
 3. Hand sanitizing stations throughout all meeting rooms.
 4. Social distancing options throughout the conference.
 5. In lieu of large swag bags given away at check-in, we will have small "Covid survival kit" lunch totes for each delegate.
 6. Colored wristbands will be provided at registration to allow attendees to indicate their preferred level of social interaction.
